1115. Sign Construction

§1115.010 <u>SIGN CONSTRUCTION; LICENSE REQUIRED, APPLICATION, FEE.</u> No person shall engage in the business of erecting, constructing, altering, maintaining, servicing, painting or posting outdoor signs without first (lst) having obtained a license from the City Council. Application for the license required by this chapter shall be upon forms provided by the City Clerk and shall be accompanied by a license fee payable to the City in the amount of thirty-five (\$35.00) dollars per year. Said license fee shall be payable prior to April first (lst) of each year. (Ref. §915.010, 915.020, Code 1966)

§1115.020 <u>SIGN CONSTRUCTION; INSURANCE</u>. No license granted under the terms stated herein, shall become effective until the licensee shall have filed with the City Clerk a copy or a certificate of insurance covering public liability insurance, which policy shall cover and protect the licensee for personal injury to the extent of one hundred thousand (\$100,000.00) dollars for each person injured and three hundred thousand (\$300,000.00) dollars for any one (1) accident or mishap and for property damaged to the extent of three hundred thousand (\$300,000.00) dollars.
