Homeowner Electrical Permit Disclosure		
Requests for Electrical Inspection (REI) with a fee of \$250.00 or less expire 12 months from the filing date. The work must completed within the 12-month period or submit another REI that includes the inspection fee for the uncompleted work. Inspection fees do not carry over from one REI to another. Minimum fee permits expire in 6 months. Refund requests must be in writing. No refunds allowed on minimum fee permits and are minus the 20% city handling fee.		
I understand that it is illegal for anyone other than the homeowner who has signed the electrical permit for or a licensed electrical contractor to do electrical wiring in Minnesota. "Anyone" includes family members and/or electricians that are not licensed contractors. The term "homeowner" refers to the person whom the property is deeded is and that this person is living at the address of the permit on file. This <i>does not</i> include duplexes, condominiums, or any other multifamily, rental occupancy, commercial or industrial properties. The homeowner doing the work shall prove to the inspector's satisfaction, that he or she is capable of performing the work to be done.
