BIDDING PROCESS FOR TREE REMOVAL

The City of White Bear Lake maintains a list of contractors to assist with the City's diseased, dying or hazardous tree removal program. This form outlines the City's process for being added to the contractor bid list for consideration.

Process

When the City's tree inspectors mark a tree for removal, the property owner is given 20 days to have it removed. The property owners may decide to remove the tree themselves or have the City handle its removal. In the event it is determined the City will handle tree removal, a bidding process with licensed contractors begins immediately.

Bid Qualifications

- Must be a licensed tree-trimming contractor with the City of White Bear Lake Building Department. Call 651-429-8518 or email the Class II Tree Trimmer License application to buildingdepartment@whitebearlake.org
- Timely response to bid requests within 1-3 days
- Tree removal and restoration completed within 20 days after the contract is awarded
- Prompt invoicing after services are performed
- Bids showing:
 - o Complete tree removal with stump grinding
 - Turf restoration of the area (black dirt and seed)
 - Final cost without tax (City is tax exempt)

Incomplete or combined bids for different properties will be not considered. You will only be notified if you are awarded the bid.
