## REAR YARD COVER WORKSHEET

The rear yard is calculated as the area between the back building wall of the house and the rear property line. If there is a jog in the back building wall of the home, use the more predominant of the two walls (i.e. the longer one). "Cover" includes accessory uses and structures. Examples of an accessory use would be a patio or driveway. An accessory structure is garage, shed, deck or other built feature. (Items such as sidewalks, garden beds, fire pits, retaining walls and swing sets are not included.)

For properties less than $\mathbf{1 0 , 0 0 0}$ square feet in size, no combination of accessory buildings or uses per single or two-family home shall cover more than $35 \%$ of the available rear yard, or no more than $42 \%$ with administrative variance.

For properties $\mathbf{1 0 , 0 0 0}$ square feet in size or greater, no combination of accessory buildings or uses per single or two-family home shall cover more than $25 \%$ of the available rear yard, or no more than $33 \%$ with administrative variance.
