### SATURDAY, MAY 30TH

On Saturday, May 30th (weather permitting), the Contractor will continue preparing the gravel base for paving on Monday. We anticipate the work will be taking place from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Saturday work is not common, so we will always notify you of this in advance.

In order to complete the construction project in the most efficient manner, it is important that the Contractor have as few obstructions as possible. **Please do not park your vehicles on Bellaire Avenue** during working hours.

### MONDAY, JUNE 1ST

Weather permitting, the contractor will begin paving the first lift of bituminous pavement on Bellaire Avenue on **Monday, June 1st**.

Please be aware that you will not be able to park on Bellaire Avenue from **7:00am until 7:00pm**. Please ensure that you have all vehicles that you will need on a side street during these hours. We apologize for any inconvenience.

**You will not be able to drive on the paved portion of the road for at least two hours or until they have finished rolling the newly paved roads. WE ASK THAT YOU TAKE EXTREME CARE NOT TO MAKE SHARP TURNS ON THE NEW BITUMINOUS PAVEMENT.**

- **WARNING**

New asphalt is very hot (**approximately 300°F**) when placed. Parents should keep children and pets from walking or riding bikes on the new pavement until it cools. Please talk to your children and explain about the paving and that they should stay a safe distance from the construction equipment.

- **SAFETY**

Due to the heavy traffic and general construction activity, we ask all parents to inform and make their children aware of the dangers of the construction sites. Please keep children a safe distance from all construction areas.
