SUBJECT: Curb & Gutter

City Project No. 22-01

Weather permitting, curb and gutter placement will begin on Friday, May 27th for all streets east of 4th Avenue that do not currently have concrete curb and gutter. The contractor will finish installing curb and gutter on Tuesday, May 31st for the remaining streets that are not curbed on Friday, May 27th. You will not be able to get in or out of your driveway from when curb is placed until the contractor has ramped your driveway with gravel, which is approximately 5 days following the curb placement. Access to the alley at Eugene Street will also be closed during this time, but access from Highway 96 will remain open.

Affected residents should have any cars, trucks, boats, etc. that you will need for the next five days out of your driveway and garage. Please park these vehicles on streets that have curb and gutter or on a street outside of the construction zone.

- After the curb and gutter has been placed you will NOT be able to use your driveway for five (5) days after concrete is poured, or until the contractor has ramped your driveway with gravel.
- You WILL be able to park in the street during the evenings after 7:00 p.m., taking extreme care not to hit the newly placed curb.
- Also, as a safety precaution, please make sure vehicles are not parked on both sides of the street directly across from each other, as the street would be too narrow for emergency vehicles to get through.
- All vehicles parked on the street need to be moved to a side street away from the construction area at the beginning of each workday (7:00 a.m.).

DRIVEWAY OPENINGS

One or two days prior to pouring the curb, will be marking your driveway openings with small white stakes. These stakes indicate the proposed extents of the curb opening (lowest "drive-able" portion of the curb). See picture at left. Generally, this will be the same width of your existing driveway. For homeowners changing the width through our driveway replacement program, we will mark the curb opening at the proposed new width.

All driveways will also include a three-foot wing on each side (as shown in the pictures below) which slopes up to match the full height of the curb.
