SUBJECT: Concrete Driveways and Aprons City Project No.: 20-01

The contractor has begun prepping and pouring concrete driveways and driveway aprons and will continue into next week until they are all completed. You will not be able to get in or out of your driveway from when the driveway or driveway apron is placed until approximately 5 days following the concrete placement.

Affected residents should have any cars, trucks, boats, etc. that you will need for the next five days out of your driveway and garage. Please park these vehicles on the street outside of the construction zone.

- After the driveway and/or apron has been placed you will NOT be able to use your driveway for five (5) days after concrete is poured, or until the contractor has ramped your driveway with gravel.
- You WILL be able to park in the street during the evenings after 7:00 p.m.
- All vehicles parked on the street need to be moved to a side street away from the construction area at the beginning of each workday (7:00 a.m.).

SAFETY REMINDER!! Due to heavy truck traffic and general construction activity, we would ask all parents to inform and make their children aware of the dangers of construction sites and to keep their children a safe distance from all construction areas. Your support and cooperation in assisting us to maintain a safe work zone and cautioning children about the dangers of construction sites will be appreciated.
