2019 STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Depending on where you live, you may have noticed that construction has commenced on the City's 2019 Street Reconstruction Project. Pavement reclamation has begun on Johnson Avenue and streets to the east of Johnson Avenue.

Many property owners have installed irrigations systems, invisible fencing, sump pump drains, and other landscape items (flower beds, rock gardens, shrubs, etc.) adjacent to the street. Because these private irrigation systems, fence systems and landscape items are within the City street right-of-way, they are potentially in the path of the reconstruction project and should be moved.

Property owners are responsible for temporarily moving or relocating their own systems. This work should be taken care of before crews start working on your street. Crews are scheduled to start on your street as early as **Monday, April 22nd**. The Engineering Department suggests that you remove sprinkler heads and plug lines that are located within 15 feet of the existing street as well as pull the pipe ends up or mark them in some way so they can be easily seen. **You** will still be **responsible** for repairing any irrigation or fencing you have placed within the right-of-way, but these suggestions will minimize costs for replacing the systems later on.
