SUBJECT:	Pavement and Curb Removal City Project No.: 21-13

One of the steps in the construction process is to remove the top layer of asphalt on the street. This work is expected to take place the week of **May 17th**. Some small sections of curb and gutter will also be removed, starting the week of **May 17th**. Curb and gutter will be marked with pink arrows if repair is planned. If curb is removed in front of your driveway, the area will be filled with gravel, and you will be able to get in or out of your driveway. As will be the case during the entire construction season, work schedules are dependent upon weather. Watch future construction updates for further information.

Please take time to mark any private irrigation systems, dog fences, etc. that are near and curb marked for removal. These are private utilities within the City right of way. You are responsible for these utilities. If damage occurs to these facilities, it is **YOUR** responsibility. The City's contractor will try to avoid damaging these private utilities, if marked by the homeowner. Please mark these to avoid damage.

In order to complete the construction project in the most efficient manner, it is important that the Contractor have as few obstructions as possible. As a friendly reminder, please **DO NOT park your vehicles, trailers and boat trailers on the streets under construction during working hours (7AM to 7PM or until work ceases for the day)**. If a vehicle and/or trailer is on the street in the construction zone during working hours and is impeding the construction, the Engineering Department will take further action and tow the obstruction. You will generally have access most of the day. If the removal is taking place directly in front of your driveway, you may not have access to your driveway for about fifteen minutes.
