Weather permitting, Forest Lake Contracting will be paving the final lift of bituminous on 11<sup>th</sup> Street (from Hwy 61 to Johnson Avenue), 10<sup>th</sup> Street (from Hwy 61 to alley), Alleys (from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to Hwy 96) and Morehead Avenue (from 11<sup>th</sup> Street to Hwy 96) above on **Monday, July 9<sup>th</sup>**.

Please be aware that you will not be able to park on your streets from 7:00am until 7:00pm and during that time, you will have limited access to your driveways. Please ensure that you have all vehicles that you will need on a side street during these hours. We apologize for any inconvenience.

You will not be able to drive on the paved portion of the road for at least two hours or until they have finished rolling the newly paved roads. WE ASK THAT YOU TAKE EXTREME CARE NOT TO MAKE SHARP TURNS ON THE NEW BITUMINOUS PAVEMENT.

## WARNING

New asphalt is very hot (<u>approximately 300°F</u>) when placed. Parents should keep children and pets from walking or riding bikes on the new pavement until it cools. Please talk to your children and explain about the paving and that they should stay a safe distance from the construction equipment.

## SAFETY

Due to the heavy traffic and general construction activity, we ask all parents to inform and make their children aware of the dangers of the construction sites. Please keep children a safe distance from all construction areas.
