Depending on where you reside, you may have noticed that construction has commenced on the City's 2019 Street Reconstruction project. Our contractor is off to a great start. Starting next Friday, May 10th, we will be sending you a bi-weekly construction newsletter.

Pavement removal on Johnson Avenue is complete, as well as 5th, 6th, and 7th Streets between Johnson Avenue and Lake Avenue. The contractor was able to grind the old pavement into gravel using a reclaiming machine, which decreases the amount of gravel hauled in from offsite.

Utility work on Johnson Avenue has begun and should be complete by Friday, May 10th. We expect utility work on 6th Street to follow the same timeline. Affected residents should have any cars, trucks, boats, etc. that they will need between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. out of their driveway and garage. Please park these vehicles outside the construction zone. Once work has ceased for the day, access to driveways will be restored.

After utility work is complete, the contractor will begin grading operations. To do this, material will be cut out of the road to make room for the gravel road base. During this process, the end of your driveway will be removed, and will be replaced during a later phase of the project.

Check your door for notices

Residents should check their doors daily for specific information regarding work occurring in the vicinity of their home (printed on brightly colored paper). If a construction notice is put in your front door, the construction activity affects your property specifically. **All notices** are emailed to the e-mail distribution list. You will need to read the e-mail notice to determine if it applies to your property specifically

Your garbage and recycling will be picked up as scheduled. Please continue to have your garbage and recycling curbside by 6:00 AM on your regularly scheduled pickup day. If the construction is too heavy in your neighborhood on your regularly scheduled pick-up day, Republic will come back the following day to pick up your garbage and recycling.
