Weather permitting, the contractor will continue paving on **Tuesday, May 17th** all streets that remain gravel west of 4th Avenue.

Please be aware that you will not be able to park **on the street** in the project area from **7:00am until 7:00pm**. Please ensure that you have all vehicles that you will need on a side street or in your driveway during these hours. If you park in your driveway, you will be able to leave but you will need to be flexible on timing as the paving operation moves past your driveway. Please consider parking on any paved street in the vicinity (4th Avenue, streets east of 4th Avenue or a freshly paved street). We apologize for any inconvenience.

You will not be able to drive on the paved portion of the road for at least two hours or until they have finished rolling the newly paved roads. WE ASK THAT YOU TAKE EXTREME CARE NOT TO MAKE SHARP TURNS ON THE NEW BITUMINOUS PAVEMENT.

- **WARNING**
New asphalt is very hot (**approximately 300°F**) when placed. Parents should keep children and pets from walking or riding bikes on the new pavement until it cools. Please talk to your children and explain about the paving and that they should stay a safe distance from the construction equipment.
- **SAFETY**
Due to the heavy traffic and general construction activity, we ask all parents to inform and make their children aware of the dangers of the construction sites. Please keep children a safe distance from all construction areas.
- **GARBAGE**
Your garbage and recycling will be picked up as scheduled. The hauler (Republic Services) will collect garbage and recycling in construction areas on schedule. Please report any missed pick-ups to: Utility Billing Clerk, Jen Carrigan, at **(651) 429-8565**.
