SUBJECT: Spot Replacement of Curb & Gutter and Road Closure

City Project No.: 19-13

Weather permitting, marked areas of curb and gutter will be removed on Thursday, May 30th and replaced on Friday, May 31st. If the damaged curb is in front of your driveway, you will not be able to get in or out of your driveway from when curb is placed until the contractor has ramped your driveway with gravel, which is approximately 5 days following the curb placement.

Residents with driveways affected should have any cars, trucks, boats, etc. that you will need for the next five days out of your driveway and garage. Please park these vehicles on the street outside of the construction zone.

In addition, a concrete valley gutter will be repaired on Friday, May 31st across Walnut Street at 9th Street. This concrete will need 5 days to cure before it can be driven across. Therefore, the south end of Walnut Street will be closed until **Friday**, **June 7th**. Residents will be not able to access 9th Street via Walnut Street until the new concrete is cured. Barricades will be placed on both sides of this valley gutter to protect it. Please do not attempt to drive across this gutter until it is cured as it will damage the concrete and may cause damage to your vehicle.

SAFETY REMINDER!! Due to heavy truck traffic and general construction activity, we would ask all parents to inform and make their children aware of the dangers of construction sites and to keep their children a safe distance from all construction areas. Your support and cooperation in assisting us to maintain a safe work zone and cautioning children about the dangers of construction sites will be appreciated.
